In English it is pronounced /ˌdʒoʊŋdʒəˈkɑːrtə/ which derives from its Dutch spelling Jogjakarta. In Javanese (and Dutch) it is pronounced [ˈjogjaˈkarta]. It is also referred to more casually as Jogja.

STMIK Amikom Yogyakarta is a result of the development of the Academy of Management Information Systems and Computer Science "Amikom" Yogyakarta. The Academy of Management Information Systems and Computer Science "Amikom" Yogyakarta was established on the same campus in 1993.

In 2000, The Academy of Management Information Systems and Computer Science "Amikom" Yogyakarta became College of Management Information Systems and Computer Science "Amikom" Yogyakarta.
